The respect for the rule of law and the pursuit of justice in times of international crisis calls practitioners, lawyers, NGOs, and academics to rationalise and apply different sets of public international law provisions – ranging from human rights law, to humanitarian law, criminal law and general theories and approaches on the reconstructions of customary rules.
